Dear UGHS Band parents:

It is time once again for our annual Filet of Chicken sale. Traditionally this sale has been one of our best fundraisers. These products are produced by a local company that provides products to restaurants throughout metro Atlanta, the state of Georgia and beyond. This includes many of the places that you and your family eat at on a regular basis. The products are restaurant size and quality, and as those of you who have had the chicken from our sales can confirm, it is very good.

We need your help with this and all of our fundraising activities throughout the year. The band at UGHS receives basically no funding from the county to operate our band program, and we do not charge any kind of participation fees for band (only about 5% of the funding for our annual operating costs comes from the county/school). You expect the best for your child, so the students and I need your help to make sure that each child, your child, has the best possible band experience while at UGHS. This year we are asking each member/family of the UGHS Band to sell a minimum of 6 boxes. As with most of our fundraisers, 50% of the profit from each item that a student/parent sells goes into that student's band account and 50% into the band's general operating account. Money accumulated in each child's account can be used for things like paying for band dresses/tuxes, marching band fees, solo and ensemble fees, district honor band, band awards banquet tickets, trip costs and other things associated with a student's participation in band.

This year our chicken sale will run from Friday, December 2 to Tuesday, December 13<sup>th</sup>. The chicken will be delivered Thursday, December 15<sup>th</sup>. Many of you have built a customer base over the past years that is ready and waiting. Your family, friends, customers, co-workers, your church kitchen manager and numerous other prospective customers are waiting for you to ask for their help to support our students in the UGHS Band.

As always, thank you for supporting our band students at UGHS.
